## 2017 Netball Umpire Program

### introduction

The Central Coast Academy of Sport (CCAS) is now accepting applications from umpires interested in selection in the 2017 Academy Netball Umpire Program. The program provides a localised training environment for eligible aspiring young netball Umpires of the NSW Central Coast region to access quality development opportunities and support.

Umpires will receive expert coaching and participate in both practical and educational development sessions throughout the program under the guidance of CCAS appointed umpire coaches. The program is recognised as part of the program pathway for umpires under the Netball NSW Pathway. The 2017 Umpire program will commence in March and run through until July 2017.

### benefits

The following benefits will apply to athletes selected within the CCAS 2017 Netball Umpire Program:

- Skills training & mentoring to further develop abilities;
- Opportunities to represent the CCAS as Umpires in the ClubsNSW Academy Games, NIB Games and various other events (selected athletes);
- Education sessions to ensure athletes also learn to prepare themselves off the court;
- A CCAS merchandise kit valued at over \$200.00;
- 20% discount on all CCAS Clothing purchases, and various other athlete discounts including preferred pricing for Victor Sports, Mingara One, Water to Go among many others.

### cost

A levy of \$200.00 (plus GST) is applicable to successful scholarship athletes and covers the full cost of participation in the program and the CCAS merchandise kit (Uniform) and tickets for athlete and their family to attend the CCAS Awards Evening (September 2017).

### athlete uniform

Athletes will receive a CCAS Netball Umpires Uniform consisting of CCAS shorts, CCAS singlet, an Umpires Skirt and Polo, Gatorade drink bottle, Gatorade, and a CCAS backpack. This uniform will be worn by athletes at CCAS training sessions and associated sessions.

### eligibility

To be eligible to apply for a 2017 Academy Netball Umpire scholarship, athletes must be

- Male or female born between 1997 and 2004 (13 to 20 years old in 2017).
- Has attained or is working towards a National Umpire Award (Badge C preferred, but not essential).
- A current financial member of a local Netball Association located within the Central Coast region
- Currently residing within the Local Government Area (LGA) of the Central Coast Council.

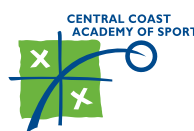
### selection process

Interested athletes are encouraged to complete the attached application form. Each applicant is reviewed by a selected panel of CCAS coaches and administrators.

If successful, the athlete levy and any previous amount owing from preceding years must be received prior to the athlete receiving their uniform and / or participating.

### athlete commitment

Athletes will be accepted as a scholarship holder upon signing an athlete agreement. Please note, umpires who have been given grants by their association must also agree to commit to their respective associations scholarship requirements.
