2017-18 ClubsNSW Basketball Program

introduction

The Central Coast Academy of Sport (CCAS) is now accepting applications from athletes interested in trialing for a scholarship position within the CCAS 2017-18 ClubsNSW basketball program.

The CCAS basketball program provides a unique opportunity for local athletes looking to gain further individual skill development and competition opportunities that will assist them in their chances of gaining future state team selection and higher honours.

The CCAS 2017-18 ClubsNSW basketball program is a Basketball NSW (BNSW) endorsed athlete pathway with genuine opportunities for athletes to progress to senior representative programs.

Athletes who are selected to BNSW SPP program will not be eligible to apply or for selection to the CCAS program.

benefits

The following benefits will apply to athletes selected:

- A minimum of 30 hours of on court high performance skills training to further develop skills;
- Specialist guest coaching sessions;
- Regular educational core units such as Decision Making/ Social Media, Nutrition & sports psychology sessions scheduled to ensure athletes also learn how to prepare themselves off the court;
- Sports science testing conducted by the University of Newcastle to ensure all aspects of fitness are improved;
- 20% discount to all CCAS merchandise and various other athlete discounts including preferred pricing for 2XU, Victor Sports, Mingara One Gym (for those 15 and over) and Water to Go, among others;
- Game play including challenge days, a squad tour and the 2018 ClubsNSW Academy Games to be held in Newcastle (27, 28 and 29 April 2018) (Tours will incur additional fees.)

athlete uniform

Athletes will receive a CCAS uniform consisting of: reversible training singlet, training shorts, polo shirt, training bag and a drink bottle. The uniform will be worn by athletes at all CCAS associated events.

eligibility

To be eligible to apply to trial for a position within the CCAS 2017-18 academy basketball scholarship, athletes must be:

- Male or female born between the years of 2003 and 2006 inclusive (U14 or U16 EJL or CPL in 2018)
- A junior representative player representing the Central Coast Waves, Gosford City Rebels in the U14 or U16 division of the Basketball NSW Eastern Junior League (EJL) or Country Premier League (CPL) in season 2018.
- Currently residing within the Local Government Area (LGA) of Central Coast Council.
- A current financial member of Basketball NSW via the home association (Gosford Rebels or CC Waves).

cost

The total fee payable is \$445.00 (+GST). The fee is broken into two parts:

1. Program Fee \$405.00 (+GST) covers the full cost of participation in the program including the CCAS merchandise kit (valued at RRP \$250.00)

2. Awards Night Fee is \$40 (+GST) & provides four (4) tickets to the CCAS Awards Celebration.

Additional costs will apply for the squad tour which is optional (details to be confirmed) and a registration fee which relates to the Annual ClubsNSW Academy Games (Selected Squad).
