## 2017/18 CCAS Callaway Golf Program

### introduction

The Central Coast Academy Of Sport (CCAS) Callaway Golf Program operates in partnership with Jack Newton Junior Golf (JNJG) to support pre-elite juniors in a local setting.

JNJG provides a golf curriculum and skill modules to support the CCAS Callaway Golf Program. The modules cover skill components, core skill testing procedures, drills and reporting protocols for all scholarship athletes.

The aim of the Central Coast Academy of Sport Callaway Golf Program is to provide aspiring young male and female golfers of the NSW Central Coast region with genuine opportunities and support to up-skill across all areas of the sport, gain educational and personal development both on and off the course, and to enhance their prospects of progressing further in the development pathway.

### selection process

Interested athletes are able to apply online at [thinksport.com.au](http://thinksport.com.au) or be nominated by their respective club.

Each applicant is reviewed by a selected panel of CCAS coaches and administrators with a representative from JNJG consulted regarding the suitability of athletes. An announcement of successful athletes will be placed on the CCAS website shortly after the closing date.

### eligibility

To be eligible for an academy golf scholarship, athletes must be:

- Male or female aged 11 to 17 year of age in 2018
- Currently residing within Central Coast Council area
- (Preferred) Handicap of <18 for boys and <27 for girls
- Representative of a local Central Coast golf club
- NB handicap has been increased to attract interested athletes to the program.

### cost

Should you be accepted into the 2017/18 program a fee of \$410.00 (+ GST) will be applied. The fee is broken into two parts.

(1) The program fee is \$370 (+GST), which covers the full cost of participation in the program including the CCAS merchandise kit (valued at RRP \$258.00).

(2) The Award Night fee is \$40 (+GST) & provides four (4) tickets to the CCAS awards night scheduled in November 2018 (Final date TBC)

(3) Additional costs will apply for non-core program elements such as tours or entry to Clubs NSW Academy Games.

### athlete benefits

Selected athletes will receive a minimum of 40 hours of on-course training through a mix of weekend and afternoon sessions including Trackman computer assessment, skill development, education and personal development sessions and the opportunity to represent the CCAS at various events. Athletes will also receive a CCAS merchandise kit consisting of 2 playing polos, golf shorts, CCAS tracksuit, CCAS backpack, and a Cap, Balls and Glove set (RRP \$250.00), a family ticket (4 pax) to the Annual Awards evening.
